

Section 3 God, the Real One, Hates THEM; Can THEY Not Take a Hint?

In my original book, “The THEorY of LIVEvolution”, I found it hard to fathom that a God of infinite mercy, kindness and compassion could hate anything. But after reading more in to the Bible and doing more research about what “THEY” have been up since the beginning of “time” it’s abundantly clear: He hates “THEM”.

This isn’t a hatred from a purely vengeance standpoint the way a certain president acts when he says anybody in his way will get punched in the mouth but one of a Father who has tried time and again to rear his rebellious child in to righteousness and the child, who was shown and knew the right way, would have none of it. At some point the Father has to let the child go which really represents that child’s leaving the eternal kingdom of God’s glory. This is illustrated in the parable of the prodigal son:

And he said, A certain man had two sons: 12 And the younger of them said to his father, Father, give me the portion of goods that falleth to me. And he divided unto them his living. 13 And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there wasted his substance with riotous living. 14 And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want. 15 And he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country; and he sent him into his fields to feed swine. 16 And he would fain have filled his belly with the husks that the swine did eat: and no man gave unto him. 17 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! 18 I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee, 19 And am no more worthy to be called thy son: make me as one of thy hired servants. 20 And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him. 21 And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son. 22 But the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet: 23 And bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it; and let us eat, and be merry: 24 For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. And they began to be merry. (Luke 15:11-24)

In this case the son decided to return which represents a sinner, any sinner, coming back humbled before God, the real One. In many places throughout the Bible He describes His mercy and patience in both Books of the Bible. Here is one example from Psalms and another from II Peter (emphasis mine):

The Lord is gracious and full of compassion; *slow to anger* and of great mercy. The Lord is good to all: and his tender mercies are over all his works. (Psalms 145:8-9)

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is *longsuffering* toward us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the

night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up (II Peter 3:9-10)

He doesn't want anybody to perish but notice it doesn't say His patience lasts forever. The more one looks at what "They" have been up to and the mess "They" have gotten the world in to it becomes readily apparent that His return at the "the day of the Lord" (i.e., Battle of Armageddon) isn't just to exact revenge on His "prodigal sons" that did NOT return but as a rescue mission for the rest of us.

But I digress.

Soon we'll get to the well known plagues of Egypt. But look at this passage from the Book of Amos for a preview of what He really thinks of sun god worship like the Ancient Egyptians and today's Kabalists discussed in the last section:

I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies. 22 Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept them: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts. 23 Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols. 24 But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream. 25 Have ye offered unto me sacrifices and offerings in the wilderness forty years, O house of Israel? 26 But ye have borne the tabernacle of your Moloch and Chiun your images, the star of your god, which ye made to yourselves. 27 Therefore will I cause you to go into captivity beyond Damascus, saith the LORD, whose name is The God of hosts. (Amos 5:21-27)

Moloch is the owl symbolic of the Caananite sun god Baal and Egyptian sun god Ra/Osiris to be discussed shortly. It also happens to be the god deified by many of "our" top leaders in the USA today, 2011 (see the [Bohemian Grove](#) link on the MYSTERY, BABYLON USA page).

Here David speaks of those the idol worshippers symbolized by Ancient Egypt:

I have hated the congregation of evil doers; and will not sit with the wicked. (Psalm 26:5)

Ephaim was one of the twelve tribes of Israel that was generally loyal to God but dabbled in the sun god worship and associated deities of the Caananites, Babylonians and Egyptians of Old Testament times. Here is one of those times where the tribe went bad:

All their wickedness is in Gilgal: for there I hated them: for the wickedness of their doings I will drive them out of mine house, I will love them no more: all their princes are revolvers. 16 Ephraim is smitten, their root is dried up, they shall bear no fruit: yea, though they bring forth, yet will I slay even the beloved fruit of their womb. 17 My God will cast them away, because they did not hearken unto him: and they shall be wanderers among the nations. (Hosea 9:15-17)

In the Old Testament God, the real One, focused on Ancient Egypt as the main symbol of the fake, god idol worship He simply could not stand. Perhaps the best known example of this Divine UN-happiness is the 10 plagues bestowed on Ancient Egypt and its pharaoh at the time, Ramses II. Of all the ancient cultures Egypt seems to be nexus of the Babylonian/Sumerian beliefs that preceded it and the Greek/Roman “mythologies” that descended from it. But before we even get there, notice this exchange:

When Pharaoh shall speak unto you, saying, Shew a miracle for you: then thou shalt say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and cast it before Pharaoh, and it shall become a serpent. 10 And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent. 11 Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments. 12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. (Exodus 7:9-12)

Which “god” of “mythology” is associated with the twisted serpents climbing up the serpent’s pole? None other than our new friend, RC Christian one in the same with Hermes who ties directly to Thoth (or Horus), the sun of the sun god Osiris/Ra who we’ll get to momentarily. Also, note that the Egyptian priests did possess limited magical powers which helps explain their hold and influence over the pharaoh and the reverence they held over the population in general.

Here’s Hermes/Thoth/RC Christian holding “his” staff (yes the same staff of healing of today’s American Medical Association):



Let’s get to the plagues.

Here they are summarized with the Egyptian “gods” (who remember sound a lot like today’s “UFOs” see [Environmental UFOs](#) link here) that were affected:

1. Plague of the Nile (Exodus 7:17-21)

Thus saith the LORD, In this thou shalt know that I am the LORD: behold, I will smite with the rod that is in mine hand upon the waters which are in the river, and they shall be turned to blood. 18 And the fish that is in the river shall die, and the river shall stink; and the Egyptians shall lothe to drink of the water of the river. 19 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and stretch out thine hand upon the waters of Egypt, upon their streams, upon their rivers, and upon their ponds, and upon all their pools of water, that they may become blood; and that there may be blood throughout all the land of Egypt, both in vessels of wood, and in vessels of stone. 20 And Moses and Aaron did so, as the LORD commanded; and he lifted up the rod, and smote the waters that were in the river, in the sight of Pharaoh, and in the sight of his servants; and all the waters that were in the river were turned to blood. 21 And the fish that was in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river; and there was blood throughout all the land of Egypt. 22 And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said. 23 And Pharaoh turned and went into his house, neither did he set his heart to this also. 24 And all the Egyptians digged round about the river for water to drink; for they could not drink of the water of the river.

Two of the main gods that ‘filtered out’ of mess of gods, goddesses, contradictions and nonsense of the Egyptian pantheon were Isis and Osiris. These two lovelies as representative of the oft mentioned male (rose)/female (cross) principle also represented agriculture. The Nile was the main source of water for the country’s agriculture and very livelihood. So Osiris who is also known as the corn god couldn’t be of much assistance when the priests prayed to “him”. Ditto the situation with Isis whose manifestation as the black Madonna (one of the predecessors to the Catholic Mary) was due to “her” association with the fertile, black dirt deposited by the waters of the Nile. This goddess like “her” husband/brother Osiris is being heavily mocked as well. And fish were highly regarded as symbols of the Egyptian gods as well. Sucks for them as can be seen here.

This is bad for the main gods of Ancient Egypt; really bad.

And we’re only on plague number one.

2. Frogs (Exodus 8:1-6)

And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me. 2 And if thou refuse to let them go, behold, I will smite all thy borders with frogs: 3 And the river shall bring forth frogs abundantly, which shall go up and come into thine house, and into thy bedchamber, and upon thy bed, and into the house of thy servants, and upon thy people, and into thine ovens, and into thy kneadingtroughs: 4 And the frogs shall come up both on thee, and upon thy people, and upon all thy servants. 5 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Stretch forth thine hand with thy rod over the streams, over the rivers, and over the ponds, and cause frogs to come up upon the land of Egypt. 6 And Aaron stretched out his hand over the waters of Egypt; and the frogs came up, and covered the land of Egypt. 7 And the magicians did so with their enchantments, and brought up frogs upon the land of Egypt. 8 Then Pharaoh called

for Moses and Aaron, and said, Intreat the LORD, that he may take away the frogs from me, and from my people; and I will let the people go, that they may do sacrifice unto the LORD.

Like many animals in Ancient Egypt frogs were held in high esteem and associated with the protector of the goddess of infants, Heka. “She” would be associated with the later Greek goddess Hecate who was goddess of fertility, the moon, the underworld and a plethora of other aspects of human existence. So by covering the ground of Egypt with frogs and their carcasses God, the real One, is making another mockery of the Egyptian pantheon and its human representatives, the Pharaoh and priests. Also, this is a coming preview of the last plague, the death of the Egyptian first born.

3. Lice (Exodus 8:16)

And the LORD said unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Stretch out thy rod, and smite the dust of the land, that it may become lice throughout all the land of Egypt. 17 And they did so; for Aaron stretched out his hand with his rod, and smote the dust of the earth, and it became lice in man, and in beast; all the dust of the land became lice throughout all the land of Egypt. 18 And the magicians did so with their enchantments to bring forth lice, but they could not: so there were lice upon man, and upon beast. 19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

The land of Egypt, the land of the so-called gods, was hallowed ground. This is where the gods and animals came from. So by producing a plague of lice from the “dust” and making every animal and human unclean God, the real One, is again mocking Pharaoh and his cohorts who were, once again, helpless to do anything. And notice that even the priests are starting to get the hint about “the finger of God”.

4. Flies (Exodus 8:20-24)

And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarms of flies shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that I am the LORD in the midst of the earth. 23 And I will put a division between my people and thy people: to morrow shall this sign be. 24 And the LORD did so; and there came a grievous swarm of flies into the house of Pharaoh, and into his servants' houses, and into all the land of Egypt: the land was corrupted by reason of the swarm of flies.

In Ancient Egypt the beetle was associated with the fly. And the beetle was one sacred insect. The Egyptians believed the beetle was a microcosmic representation of the sun god Ra since there was no female beetle; it merely rolled up a ball of ox dung and the dirt/dung combination produced new beetles. Of course this is how Ra, the original creator god, got the ball rolling, no pun intended, on all animal and human life on earth. Khepri was also associated with Ra and yet another Egyptian god in the mess of Egyptian theology. He was often shown as a beetle head on a human body. It's also worth mentioning that the Mesopotamian deity Beelzebub who later became the Canaanite Baal was known as “Lord of the Flies”. And once again the pantheon of

Egyptian sun gods and nature goddesses were helpless to help out Egypt and get rid of this putrid invasion of flies.

Here's an image from George Washington's Masonic museum in Washington DC:

Besides the beetle like insects on top of the Masonic column notice the ears of corn symbolic of their god of agriculture, the sun god Ra/Osiris. (As an aside, this "conspiracy theorist" doesn't subscribe to Washington as taking an active part in this whole mess; a lot of "his" Temple was done after his death).

5 and 6. Dead cows and boils Exodus (9:1-11)

Then the LORD said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh, and tell him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, Let my people go, that they may serve me. 2 For if thou refuse to let them go, and wilt hold them still, 3 Behold, the hand of the LORD is upon thy cattle which is in the field, upon the horses, upon the asses, upon the camels, upon the oxen, and upon the sheep: there shall be a very grievous murrain. 4 And the LORD shall sever between the cattle of Israel and the cattle of Egypt: and there shall nothing die of all that is the children's of Israel. 5 And the LORD appointed a set time, saying, To morrow the LORD shall do this thing in the land. 6 And the LORD did that thing on the morrow, and all the cattle of Egypt died: but of the cattle of the children of Israel died not one. 7 And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go. 8 And the LORD said unto Moses and unto Aaron, Take to you handfuls of ashes of the furnace, and let Moses sprinkle it toward the heaven in the sight of Pharaoh. 9 And it shall become small dust in all the land of Egypt, and shall be a boil breaking forth with blains upon man, and upon beast, throughout all the land of Egypt. 10 And they took ashes of the furnace, and stood before Pharaoh; and Moses sprinkled it up toward heaven; and it became a boil breaking forth with blains upon man, and upon beast. 11 And the magicians could not stand before Moses because of the boils; for the boil was upon the magicians, and upon all the Egyptians.

Now things are getting serious as if they haven't already. All their farm animals are affected but the Egyptians deified bulls and cows; literally. Bulls were often the central part of religious ceremonies and taken care of by the best physicians. This is no surprise as they were considered



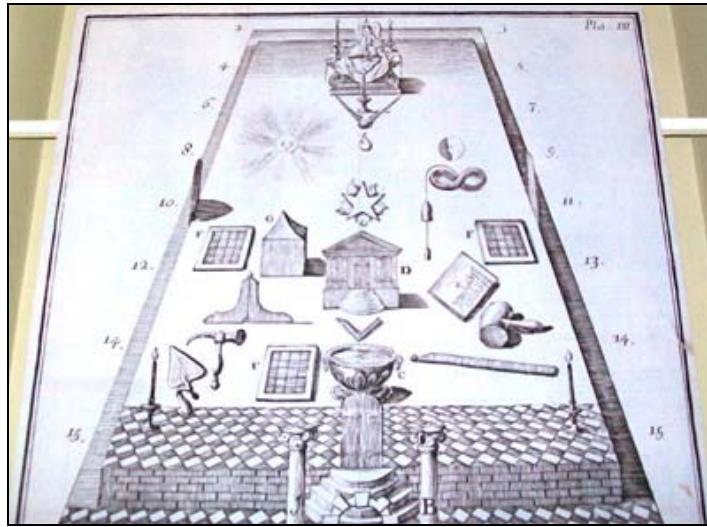
direct representations of the architect god Ptah and the sun god Osiris. Serapis was yet another Egyptian god that was invented to combine the strength and vitality of the bull with Osiris. And on the female side the cow headed goddess Hathor carried the sun disc between “her” horns. Her name was also “Lady of the Universe”, “Lady of Heaven” and the “Celestial Cow”. “She” is a close relative to the Egyptian goddess of whoredom, Isis and the black Madonna mentioned earlier who is now the Catholic “Queen of Heaven”, Mary. And not only is God, the real One, making a complete mockery of this whole deified bull/cow complex to add insult to injury He rolls right into the plague of the boils. Even the high priests were subject to these boils but as usual Pharaoh refuses to take the hint as the Israelites are exempt from the whole thing.

Here’s another shot of Washington’s Masonic Temple in Washington, D.C.:



Notice the seven steps to get up to this point. This is symbolized by the pervasive use of the number 7 by the Freemasons including the 7 subjects of initiation (grammar, rhetoric, logic, arithmetic, grammar, music and astronomy), the 7 stars of the Pleiades (the seven Greek daughters of god Atlas and goddess Pleione found in the constellation Taurus), the 7 planets (visible from earth, Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Saturn and Jupiter), etc.

This sits in between the two lotus headed columns of Freemasonry, the columns of Solomon’s Temple, Joachim and Boaz. These are pervasive in all symbols of Freemasonry. Notice the symbols in this Masonic painting in Washington’s Masonic Temple:



We have the lotus headed (or beetle headed as shown before) columns of Joachim and Boaz. Notice both the serpent and lightly printed sun symbolic of the sun god Ra/Osiris. But according to the History Channel Freemasons this all has nothing to do with religion...

7. Hail (Exodus 9:13)

Behold, to morrow about this time I will cause it to rain a very grievous hail, such as hath not been in Egypt since the foundation thereof even until now. 19 Send therefore now, and gather thy cattle, and all that thou hast in the field; for upon every man and beast which shall be found in the field, and shall not be brought home, the hail shall come down upon them, and they shall die. 20 He that feared the word of the LORD among the servants of Pharaoh made his servants and his cattle flee into the houses: 21 And he that regarded not the word of the LORD left his servants and his cattle in the field. 22 And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch forth thine hand toward heaven, that there may be hail in all the land of Egypt, upon man, and upon beast, and upon every herb of the field, throughout the land of Egypt. 23 And Moses stretched forth his rod toward heaven: and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and the fire ran along upon the ground; and the LORD rained hail upon the land of Egypt. 24 So there was hail, and fire mingled with the hail, very grievous, such as there was none like it in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation. 25 And the hail smote throughout all the land of Egypt all that was in the field, both man and beast; and the hail smote every herb of the field, and brake every tree of the field. 26 Only in the land of Goshen, where the children of Israel were, was there no hail.

Now the ante is upped yet again and as usual Pharaoh and the priests are helpless in this rain of hail and the Israelites are exempt. This plague in particular is a direct mockery of the earliest Egyptian deities that preceded Isis (female) and Osiris (male). That would be the sky goddess Nut and sun god Ra who were responsible for controlling the weather and the sun. Obviously a plague of hail and their inability to stop it belittles their status. And the sun of Ra/Osiris or Horus who was supposedly re-incarnated as each Pharaoh still isn't taking the hint.

8. Locusts (Exodus 10:3-6; 13-15)

And Moses and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, How long wilt thou refuse to humble thyself before me? let my people go, that they may serve me. 4 Else, if thou refuse to let my people go, behold, to morrow will I bring the locusts into thy coast: 5 And they shall cover the face of the earth, that one cannot be able to see the earth: and they shall eat the residue of that which is escaped, which remaineth unto you from the hail, and shall eat every tree which groweth for you out of the field: 6 And they shall fill thy houses, and the houses of all thy servants, and the houses of all the Egyptians; which neither thy fathers, nor thy fathers' fathers have seen, since the day that they were upon the earth unto this day. And he turned himself, and went out from Pharaoh.

And Moses stretched forth his rod over the land of Egypt, and the LORD brought an east wind upon the land all that day, and all that night; and when it was morning, the east wind brought the locusts. 14 And the locust went up over all the land of Egypt, and rested in all the coasts of Egypt: very grievous were they; before them there were no such locusts as they, neither after them shall be such. 15 For they covered the face of the whole earth, so that the land was darkened; and they did eat every herb of the land, and all the fruit of the trees which the hail had left: and there remained not any green thing in the trees, or in the herbs of the field, through all the land of Egypt.

Once again, God the real One, makes a mockery of the entire pantheon of Egyptian gods and goddesses of earth, the Nile, agriculture and their human representatives of priests and Pharaoh who were once again rendered completely powerless as the locusts devoured everything in sight including the nation's agriculture.

9. Darkness (Exodus 10:21-23)

And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, even darkness which may be felt. 22 And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days: 23 They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings.

There was no light; the sun was essentially turned off. Obviously this is a huge demoralization for a people whose very existence and idea of goodness relied on the light and energy provided by the sun god Ra and his eventual sun Thoth/Horus.

10. Death of first born (Exodus 11:4-5)

And Moses said, Thus saith the LORD, About midnight will I go out into the midst of Egypt: 5 And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the first born of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

Needless to say child sacrifice has been huge throughout human history in many cultures that worshipped the archetype 'sun god' which in Egypt was typified by Ra and later many others including Osiris. Of course the elites like the Pharaoh here took great care of their first born

especially the son as he represented the sun of god, or Thoth/Horus. As such these deities were supposed to protect the first born and once again they were rendered impotent.

Recall, before these plagues even started the staff of Thoth/Hermes (i.e., RC Christian) was literally eaten alive by the staff of Moses. So it begins and ends with a direct attack on our new friend, Robert Christian of the 6+6+6 or Rose Cross degree of Freemasonry. The same Freemasonry which idiotically enough still venerates many of the aforementioned symbols as shown here in photos recently taken in George Washington's Masonic Museum in Washington DC as indicated by the previous photos.

Another god directly attacked with the death of Pharaoh's first born is the Egyptian god Min, the god of sexuality and sexual vibrancy. He would later be associated with the Greek god Pan (the origin of the word "Pandemonium") and the horned god. And where do we see Pan prominently displayed today? Right beneath the largest cathedral in the world, Saint John's the Divine under the watchful eye of "the father" represented by the cap less pyramid of Giza and its all seeing eye of the sun god Ra/Osiris/Apollo (see [The Modern Environmental Movement/Saint John's the Divine Cathedral](#) link).

There are several observances to take from this. First, agree or disagree with the harshness of this progression of plagues God, the real One, leaves no doubt on where He stands with the Egyptians so there's a definite separation here. So one has to ask how it is that a group like say the Gnostics or many of today's "New" Agers can claim that Christianity is somehow related or rooted in this very system. Secondly, notice the progression here. Apparently the Ancient Egyptian ruling class and its related astrologers, priest and associated devil worshipping types couldn't take the hint. This is the same group that influenced Greek philosophers like Plato and his philosophical descendants known today as communists, socialists, British Round Table Groups and its American offshoot Council on Foreign Relations, the American Illuminati Skull and Bones and specifically the Ivy League Ivory Tower God sucks/we rule types that currently occupy the White House. Continuing, notice the reason why Pharaoh didn't take the hints: his own priests had their limited abilities with extra-human technology and/or "magical" powers. So their "gods" (the aforementioned fallen angels) really were able to perform feats that would be considered "miraculous" today.

Finally, if one is to take the Bible seriously, which one should, you can see there is some very awful stuff going on here. And our Illuminist/Freemason/Skull and Bones cult leaders who today comprise "[The UN-American Genocidal Complex](#)" certainly read the Bible as mentioned throughout this series of links and developed further in the next section related to numbers. But like Pharaoh here and the Pharisees lambasted by Jesus Christ, the real One, as being of "your father the devil" it's readily apparent "THEY" simply do not take hints very well as "THEY" revel in the same symbolism, worship the same gods and compete for the same power and control of earthly kingdoms as represented by the Egyptian Pharaoh.

Overall this ties in thematically with "The Late Great USA" itself. We sacrifice the unborn and the recently born if Obama, who voted against something called the Born Alive Infant Abortion Protection Act, has his way. We sacrifice farm land to grow corn for the global warming scam while people starve across the globe. Yet according to the UN-dead we're now literally deifying animals and 'Gaia' (i.e., the female Egyptian deities) as they seek rights for "Mother Earth". This all ties in with the Gaia hypothesis and the anti-10 commandments of Robert Christian covered both in this series of links and [322, the Georgia Guidestones and the eco wackos](#) link on the new age page. This can't go anywhere good as humans are sacrificed to help out Gaia and

“her” husband Baal/Osiris/Ra/Beezlebub. Yet again we have the concept of the UN-holy marriage of the two main deities of Ancient Egypt guided along by their sun, Thoth (Horus).

But the results are already in: God the real One 10; “THEM” 0.
